1. Introduction

- a. This website www.vantagere.co.uk (“Our Site”) uses Cookies and similar technologies in order to distinguish you from other users. By using Cookies, we are able to provide you with a better experience and to improve Our Site by better understanding how you use it. Please read this Cookie Policy carefully and ensure that you understand it.
- b. Your acceptance of Our Cookie Policy is deemed to occur if you continue using Our Site OR when you have selected your preferred Cookie options in Our Cookie popup and pressed the Save button. If you do not agree to Our Cookie Policy, please stop using Our Site immediately.

2. Definitions and Interpretation

- a. In this Cookie Policy, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

“**Cookie**” means a small file placed on your computer or device by Our Site when you visit certain parts of Our Site and/or when you use certain features of Our Site;

“**Cookie Law**” means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 and, where applicable, the UK GDPR

“**personal data**” means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data, as defined by the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018 (the “Data Protection Legislation”); and

“**We/Us/Our**” means Vantage RE Ltd, a limited company registered in England under company number 11023558, whose registered address is 1st Floor, Sackville House, 143-149 Fenchurch Street, London EC3M 6BL UK and whose main trading address is Vantage RE Limited 91 Wimpole Street, London W1G 0EF.

3. Information About Us

- a. Our Site is owned and operated by Vantage RE a limited company registered in England under company number 11023558 whose registered address is 1st Floor, Sackville House, 143-149 Fenchurch Street, London EC3M 6BL UK and whose main trading address is 91 Wimpole Street, London W1G 0EF.
- b. Our VAT number is: 383 8673 47.

4. How Does Our Site Use Cookies?

- a. Our Site may place and access certain first party Cookies on your computer or device. First party Cookies are those placed directly by Us and are used only by Us. We use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of Our Site. We have carefully chosen these Cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and personal data is protected and respected at all times.

- b. By using Our Site, you may also agree to receive certain third party Cookies on your computer or device. Third party Cookies are those placed by websites, services, and/or parties other than Us. Third party Cookies are used on Our Site to measure how visitors use it. For more details, please refer to section 4 below.
- c. All Cookies used by and on Our Site are used in accordance with current Cookie Law. We may use some or all of the following types of Cookie:
- I. **Functionality Cookies**
Functionality Cookies enable Us to provide additional functions to you on Our Site such as personalisation and remembering your saved preferences. Some functionality Cookies may also be strictly necessary Cookies, but not all necessarily fall into that category.
 - II. **Analytics/Performance Cookies**
It is important for Us to understand how you use Our Site, for example, how efficiently you are able to navigate around it, and what features you use. Analytics Cookies enable Us to gather this information, helping Us to improve Our Site and your experience of it.
 - III. **Persistent Cookies**
Any of the above types of Cookie may be a persistent Cookie. Persistent Cookies are those which remain on your computer or device for a predetermined period and are activated each time you visit Our Site.
 - IV. **Session Cookies**
Any of the above types of Cookie may be a session Cookie. Session Cookies are temporary and only remain on your computer or device from the point at which you visit Our Site until you close your browser. Session Cookies are deleted when you close your browser.
- d. Cookies on Our Site are not permanent and will expire as indicated in the table below.

exp_csrf_token	A security cookie used to identify the user and prevent Cross Site Request Forgery attacks.	Yes
exp_tracker	Contains the last 5 pages viewed, encrypted for security. Typically used for form or error message returns.	Functionality
PHPSESSID	A session cookie that is used to identify a user's session on a website. It is commonly used in PHP-based web applications to store a unique identifier for a user's session on the server. When a user visits a website that uses PHP sessions, a PHPSESSID cookie is sent to the	Yes

	user's browser and is stored on the user's computer. The server uses this cookie to identify the user's session and retrieve the appropriate data for that session. The PHPSESSID cookie is typically set to expire when the user closes their web browser	
breadcrumb	Contains the last page visited to enable you to navigate back to the originating page when clicking on a link.	Functionality

- b. Our Site uses analytics services provided by Google. Website analytics refers to a set of tools used to collect and analyse anonymous usage information, enabling Us to better understand how Our Site is used. This, in turn, enables Us to improve Our Site. You do not have to allow Us to use these Cookies, however whilst Our use of them does not pose any risk to your privacy or your safe use of Our Site, it does enable Us to continually improve Our Site, making it a better and more useful experience for you.
